

# 2005-2009 Mustang Radio Button Restoration

**Tools needed for repair:** razor blade, hand sanitizer, small piece of 800 grit sand paper, and a small paint brush.

**Step 1.** Use the back “non-sharpened” side of the razor knife to scrape away an fading paint chips from the center area of the button. You don’t have to scrape the entire button off but you do want to make sure the center area is clear so the light will pass through the new button text correctly.

**Step 2.** Carefully use a small piece of fine sand paper to smooth out any rough edges on the button Face. Make sure to take your time and not hit surrounding radio face with the sand paper.

**Step 3.** Use a small paint brush to clean around the edges and remove any dust particles from the previous sanding step.

**Step 4.** Using your razor knife tip, gently separate the button edge from the gloss sheet it comes on. With the button pulled off of the paper, wet the adhesive side generously with hand sanitizer. The hand sanitizer will allow the button film to be moved into place once it is applied to the button face. This will allow you to properly line up the button film in it proper place before the adhesive sets.

**Step 5.** Once the button film is in its proper place, allow hand sanitizer to dry so the film does not move anymore. Press button and hold for 30 seconds to make sure film secures firmly with the button face.
