### **FORD:**

2012-2013 Mustang 2012 F-150

## **ISSUE**

2012-2013 Mustang vehicles equipped with 3.7L engine and 2012 F-150 vehicles equipped with a 3.7L or 3.5L GTDI engine, and built on or between 1/6/2012 - 5/25/2012 may exhibit a chirping or squealing noise from the accessory drive belt during idle and acceleration.

#### ACTION

Follow the service procedure to correct the condition.

#### SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Determine vehicle build date.
  - a. Vehicle build date is on or between 1/6/2012 5/25/2012, proceed to Step 2.
  - Vehicle build date is not on or between 01/06/2012 - 05/25/2012, refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 303-05 for normal diagnostics.
- Replace accessory drive belt and accessory drive belt tensioner. Refer to WSM, Section 303-05.
